ABSTINENCE: Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligations of abstinence.

Abstinence is to be observed on the Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be used at all. Regarding all the other weekdays of Lent, we strongly recommend participation in daily Mass and the voluntary observance of fasting.
