Grades 1-7: Classes will be offered during the following timeslots:
Mondays, 4:30-5:30 p.m. **Tuesdays, 4:30-5:30 p.m.**
Mondays, 6:00-7:00 p.m. **Tuesdays, 6:00-7:00 p.m.**

Please note that all classes will be held in the Lower School on Washington Street and that slots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis as classroom capacities are limited. **The first class for students in Grades 1-8 will take place on Monday and Tuesday, September 20th & 21st.** You will be receiving a schedule which will include class dates for the entire religious ed year.

Grade 8: Our Grade 8 Program will meet approximately twice per month on Sundays, beginning with the **11:00 a.m. Mass – sessions end at 1:30 p.m.** and will take place in the Upper School building on the corner of Prospect Street and Washington Street. **Our first class for students will take place on Sunday, September 26th.** You will be receiving a schedule which will include session dates for the entire religious ed year.

Grade 9: Our Grade 9 Program will meet approximately twice per month on **Sundays, beginning with the 11:00 a.m. Mass – sessions end at 1:30 p.m.** and will take place in Meehan Hall in the Upper School building on the corner of Prospect Street and Washington Street. **Our first class for students will take place on Sunday, September 26th.** You will be receiving a schedule which will include session dates for the entire religious ed year.

Grade 10: Our Grade 10 Program will meet twice per month on **Sundays, beginning with the 5:00 p.m. Mass – sessions end at 8:15 p.m.** and will take place in Meehan Hall in the Upper School building on the corner of Prospect Street and Washington Street. **The first session will take place on September 26th.** You will be receiving a schedule which will include session dates for the entire religious ed year.
